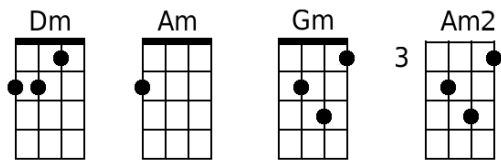


# God Rest Ye Merry, Gentlemen
